Houston, Texas – Woodward L. “Woody” Vogt, P.E., F.ACI, President of Paradigm Consultants has been named Fellow by the American Society of Civil Engineers (ASCE). Mr. Vogt received a bachelor’s degree in engineering mechanics and a master’s degree in civil engineering from Georgia Tech, is a licensed professional engineer in Texas and Louisiana, and has been a member of ASCE for 28 years. He has more than 35 years experience encompassing geotechnical and materials engineering, construction materials engineering and testing. He is also a Fellow of American Concrete Institute (ACI) International, and has served as Secretary of the Materials Engineering Division of the Texas Section of ASCE, as Director and President of the Houston Chapter of the American Concrete Institute, as a director of the Texas Council of Engineering Laboratories, and was a co-founder of the Houston Chapter of the International Concrete Repair Institute. He currently serves as a director of the American Association for Laboratory Accreditation (A2LA) and is Vice Chair of the Construction Materials Engineering and Testing Committee of ASFE.

In 1995, he was one of the founders of Paradigm Consultants, Inc., a Houston-based firm providing our public and private clients with professional geotechnical engineering, construction materials testing services and environmental engineering services.
