Houston, Texas – Paradigm Consultants, Inc. was recently awarded a \$440,000 contract with the Port of Houston Authority (POHA) to perform construction materials verification testing at the Bayport Terminal Phase 1 Container Yard, and the Entry / Exit Pre-Check and Inspection Facilities at Barbours Cut Terminal, Phase 2.

The Phase 1 Container Yard project includes more than 50 acres of pavement, extensive underground utilities and high mast lighting, and has a construction cost of approximately \$35,000,000. The Barbours Cut facility includes 20 acres of paving, 34,000 feet of underground utilities, four single-story buildings and 4,200 linear feet of perimeter fencing with an estimated construction cost of \$20,000,000.

In 2004, Paradigm was awarded a \$1.492 million contract with the POHA for Portland Cement Concrete testing at Bayport Terminal Complex, Phase 1A. The firm was named the Port of Houston Authority's Small Business of the Year in spring 2005.
